### **IV. CLINICAL WORKS**

The Outpatient Clinic of the Univ. Dept of Dermatology, is functioning by Anthony Karpouzis, every Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and during the 11 years of his assignment (until May 20, 2011), Mr. Karpouzis examined totally 37337 patients (in the Outpatient Clinic), as follows:

From December of 2002, a great number of patients (314 in all) was hospitalized in the 4 beds of the Univ. Dept of Dermatology. Mr. Karpouzis meets the needs (in Dermatological opinions) of all the Depts of the Univ. Hospital of Alexandroupolis, during the 11 years period of his service Additionally, he carries out 15 or 16 duties per month, in the Univ. Hospital of Alexandroupolis. A great number of electro coagulations and cryotherapies was carried out during the outpatient clinic functioning.

## V. TEACHING, INSTRUCTIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL WORKS

From the beginning of his assignment in Democritus' Univ. of Thrace (until now), Mr. Karpouzis (in collaboration, with the Titular Professor of Dermatology) accomplishes teaching lectures (2 hours every Tuesday, 2 hours every Wednesday, in the sixth half year of studies). Moreover, Mr. Karpouzis develops lectures (1 hour per 2 months) of Dermatology, in the setting of the Univ. Paediatrics Dept instructional programme. Also, he accomplished lectures and in several other Depts programme (First Univ. Dept of Internal Medicine, Univ. Dept of Pathology, Instructional Programme of articled physicians in General Medicine, post-graduate studies programme in "Health Care and Safety during Labour"). Articled physicians in General medicine, articled physicians in Medicine of Labour, as well as Students in Medicine, are instructed in the Outpatient Clinic as well as in the approach and management of the hospitalized patients of the Univ. Dept of Dermatology.
