In addition I acquired experience in minor procedures such as aneurysm catheterizations-embolizations, manipulation of fractures, reduction of dislocations, emergency medicine, anesthesia out of theatre (MRI and CT, Emergency Department), gastroscopies etc. In all these cases I was the anesthesiologist in charge.

In addition to my clinical duties as an Associate Professor, I have been teaching Anesthesiology to the medical students of the Medical School of Democritus University and to post-graduate students in their studies for four MSc degree programs, as are mentioned further in my CV under the title "Academic experience and teaching".
